



ENTRY FORM ***BASICS*** FOR THE NEW EXHIBITOR

ENTRY FORM TERMINOLOGY and ***ABBREVIATIONS***

PLEASE NOTE: Entry forms are not all the same, they may look different but they are all asking for the same information. Please read each form carefully.

Some shows have two entry forms available. One for the JUNIOR SHOW, one for the OPEN SHOW. Some shows combine both types of the shows on one form. Be aware and read your entry forms being sure to mark which show you are entering.

TERMINOLOGY

BREED:

Enter the proper name of your breed from the APA Standard of Perfection

VARIETY: Enter the proper variety of your bird:

(White, Splash, Mottled, Light, Dark, Buff, etc.)

(Bearded (b) or Non-Bearded (nb))

IDENTIFYING THE SEX OF THE BIRD:

The entry form will have columns for each age of the breed & variety of the birds you have entered.

Example: You may be entering a total of 7 Splash Silkies (non-bearded—NB) & 4 Dark Brahmans.

Your form regarding the sex of the bird will look like this:

DOUBLE COOP: (DC)

Double Cooping is allowed for large fowl birds only. This means the single coop is opened to double its size to allow for larger birds with long tails, massive size, etc. The cost of double cooping is sometimes charged a double entry fee since the bird is taking up two coop (cage) holes. Example: Entering a LF Brahma cock requesting a double coop. If the entry fee is \$3.00 you will be expected an additional fee as designated by the host club for using two holes for this one bird. Double fee would be \$6.00 for using two holes. Some shows may
